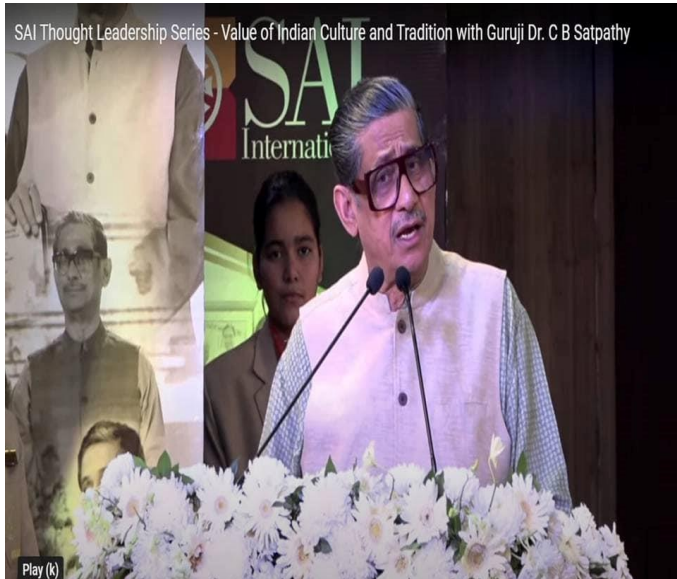

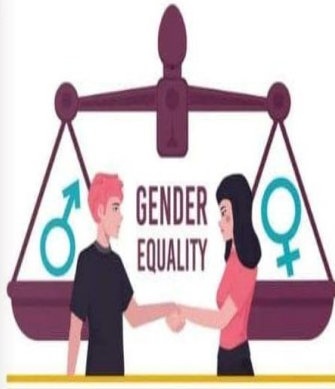

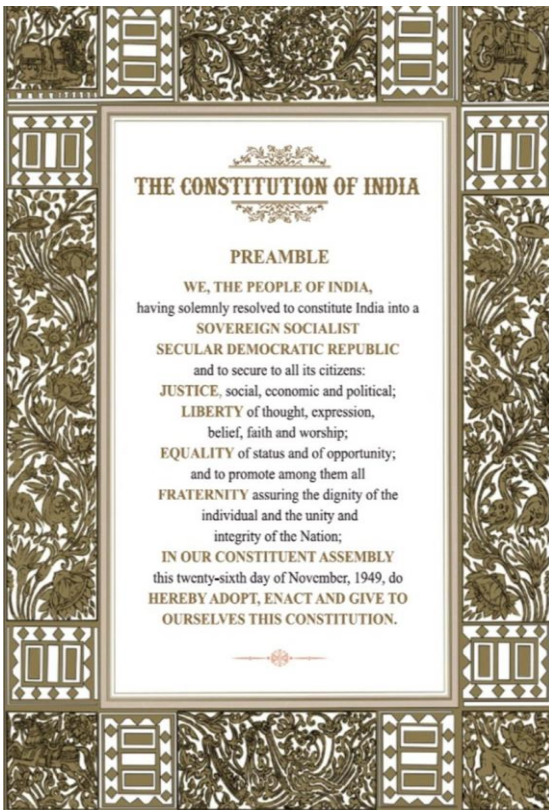
Holi celebration at SSPS

Students of SSPS attended the session and learnt the positive aspects of examination





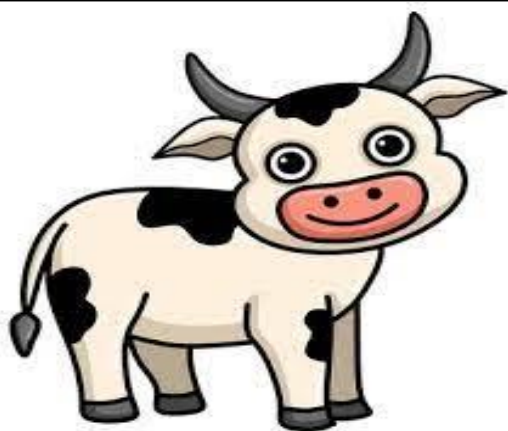
Learning Beyond the Classroom
