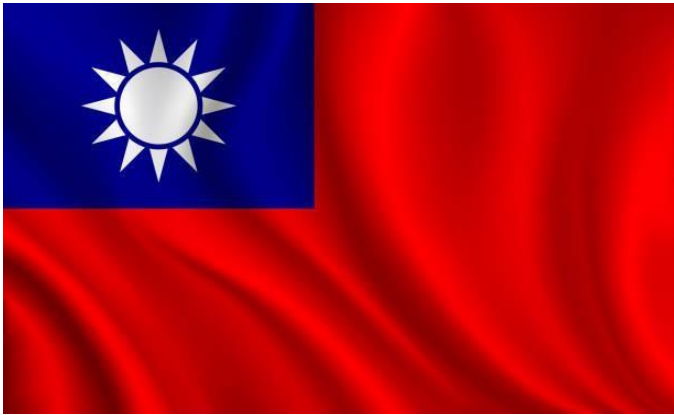

- *Also used(but less than Mandarin):Hakka, aboriginal language and Taiwanese Hokkien

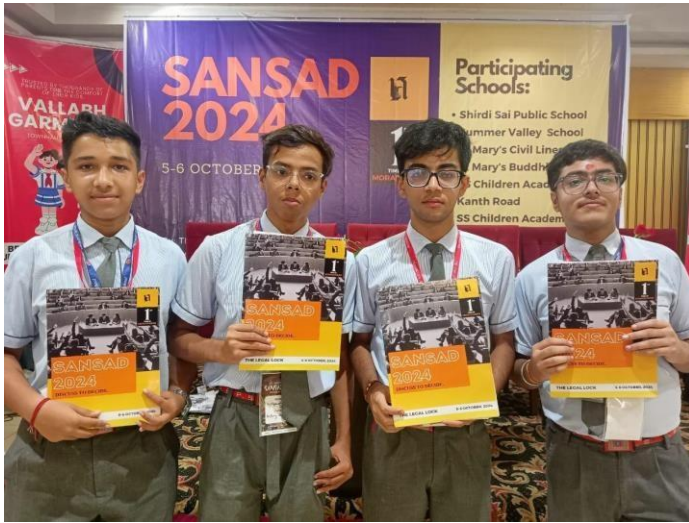

Srajan Malik of participated in UCMAS Abacus & Mental Arithmetic Competition and bagged a Trophy for being the Runner up.

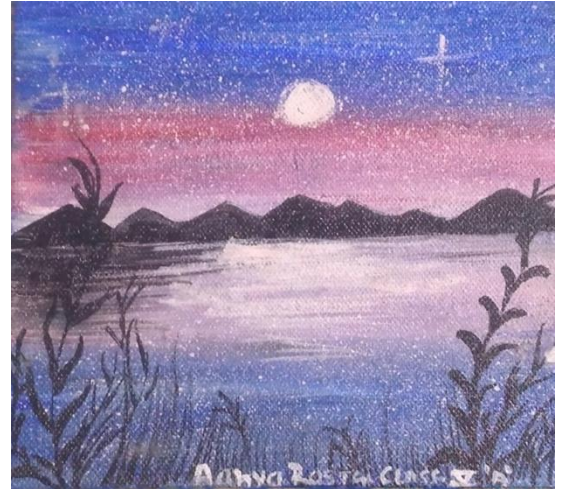

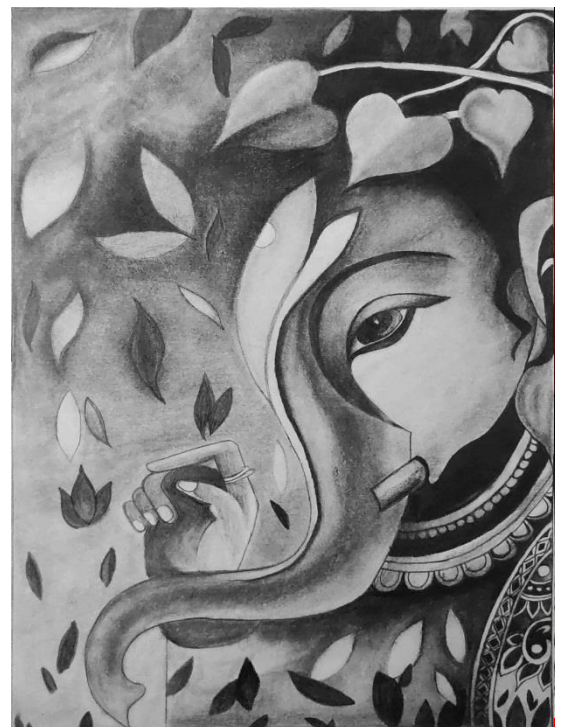
