SPIC MACAY – SITAR RECITAL

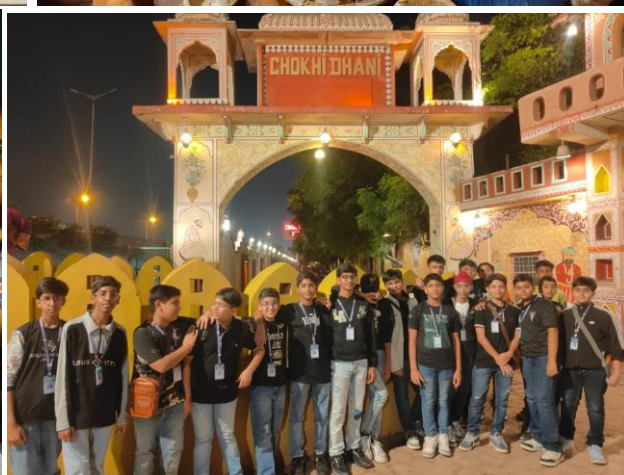
